Feb Fire & Ice Festival on Family

Think glowing ice sculptures, crackling fire pits, bundled-up kids, and that fun winter energy that makes getting out of the house actually feel worth it. It's an easy, walk-around event with activities for kids, warm-up spots for parents, and a relaxed community vibe that doesn't feel overwhelming. Dress warm, bring a thermos, and plan to wander at your own pace. This is one of those simple local events that turns into a core memory and reminds families why they love living here.

May International Children's Festival

Is a highlight for families and one of those events you circle on the calendar every year. Designed especially for kids, this multi-day festival brings together live performances, interactive shows, creative activities, and hands-on fun that actually keeps little ones engaged. St. Albert Farmer's Market

Every Saturday from June through October, the St. Albert Farmers' Market runs from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM and is one of those must-do summer traditions for local families. Local tip: park & Ride with the St. Albert Centre Transit Exchange that picks you up at the St. Albert Centre Transit station and drops you off on Perron Street. Rock'n August

Is one of St. Albert's biggest summer events and a can't-miss weekend for families in 2026. Downtown fills up with hundreds of classic cars, live music, food trucks, vendors, and that electric small-town energy that makes strolling with kids actually fun. You can pop in for an hour or make a full afternoon of it, checking out shiny cars, grabbing snacks, and letting the kids soak it all in. It's busy in the best way, well-organized, and one of those events locals plan their summer around, because it's just that good.

The Snowflake Festival

Is one of those feel-good winter events that officially kicks off the holiday season in St. Albert. Downtown lights up with festive displays, family activities, music, and that magical buzz kids absolutely love.
