Tunnel Alert

Warning when your commute includes dreaded tunnel traffic

Western Branch (Chesapeake)



Suburban feel, strong community, great schools

Commute: 20–25 min to Norfolk Naval Base (no tunnel)

Price Range: \$375K–\$500K

Great for: Military families, move-up buyers, low-stress commuters

Watch out for: I-664 congestion during rush hour

Local tip: One of the best "value-for-commute" areas in the Southside

Bayview (Norfolk)

Coastal/urban mix near the bay, beachy vibe without the crowds

Commute: 10–15 min to base

Price Range: \$250K–\$400K

Great for: First-time buyers, single service members, beach lovers

Watch out for: Smaller yards, older homes needing updates

Local tip: You can find charm and proximity without sacrificing budget



Churchland (Portsmouth)



Quiet, affordable, close to the water and shopping

Commute: 15–20 min to base via Midtown or High Rise Bridge

Price Range: \$225K–\$350K

Great for: Budget-conscious VA buyers, commuters to both Norfolk & Portsmouth

Watch out for: Limited new construction

Local tip: You *do not* have to cross a tunnel to get to base from here

Harbour View / Northern Suffolk

Newer developments, shopping, walkable pockets

Commute: 25–35 min to base

Price Range: \$375K–\$550K

Great for: Dual-income military couples, suburban buyers

Watch out for: Slightly longer drive during peak traffic

Local tip: Close to Amazon, Sentara BelleHarbour, and great schools



East Beach / Ocean View (Norfolk)



Oceanfront city living with military convenience

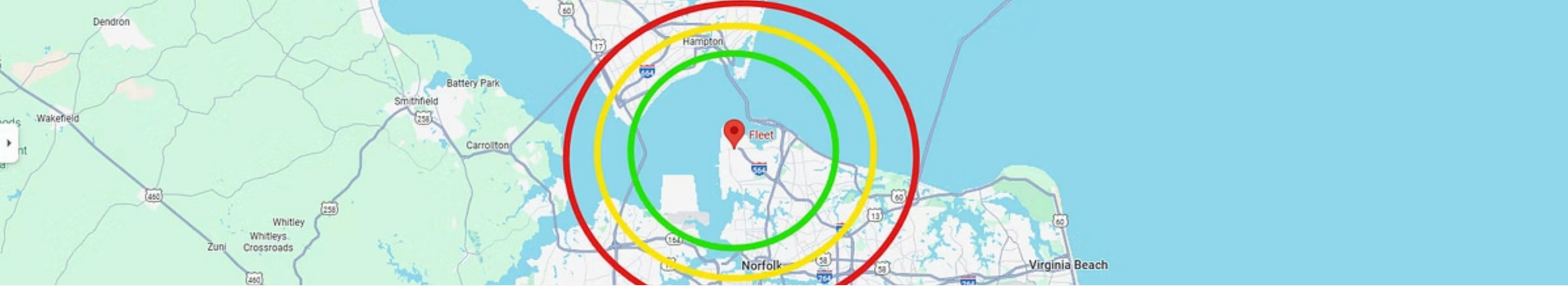
Commute: 5-10 min to base

Price Range: \$300K-\$600K

Great for: Active duty singles, couples, beach lovers

Watch out for: Street parking, flood zones, and some spotty areas

Local tip: Walk to the beach from some blocks
