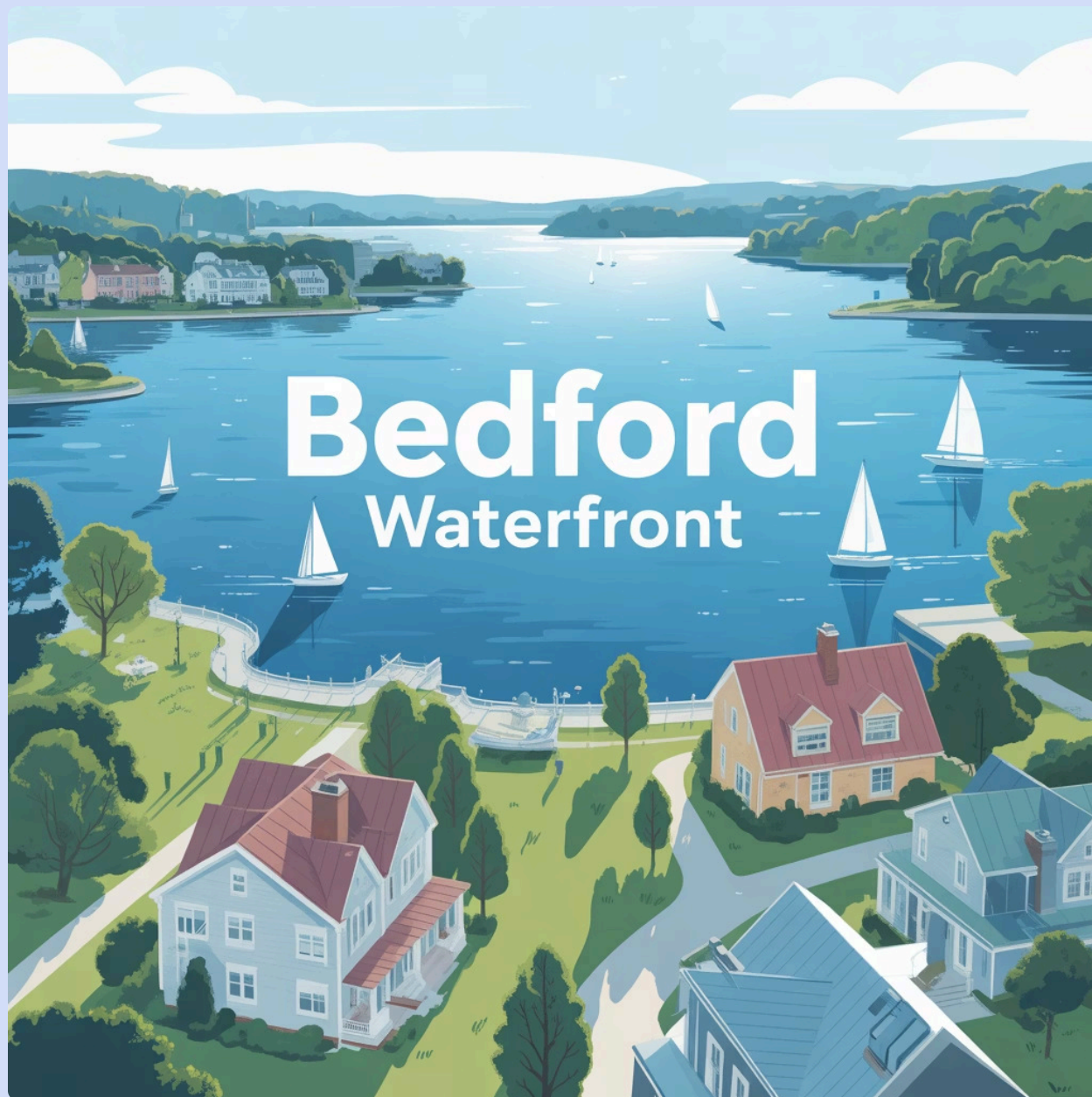

Dartmouth: Affordable Gateway

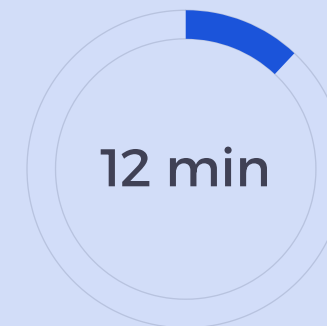
