Homes & Real Estate Snapshot

Poulsbo's housing inventory is diverse, which makes it appealing to a wide range of buyers:

- Single-family homes dominate the market
- Condos and townhomes are primarily near downtown and major roads
- Waterfront and view properties command a premium
- Newer construction is available and abundant.

Local insight: Homes that are well-prepared and priced correctly tend to move faster here, especially in neighborhoods close to downtown or commuter routes. Inventory can feel limited at times, which makes strategy and timing especially important during transitions.

Prices and availability vary by neighborhood, lot size, and proximity to the water or downtown.

Commuting & Accessibility

Poulsbo is well-situated for commuters:

- Quick access to Highway 305
- Short drive to Bainbridge ferry (Seattle commuters)
- Short drive to Kingston Ferry (Edmonds commuters)
- Easy reach to Bremerton, Silverdale, Bangor, and PSNS
- Quick, 1 hour drive to SEATAC airport
