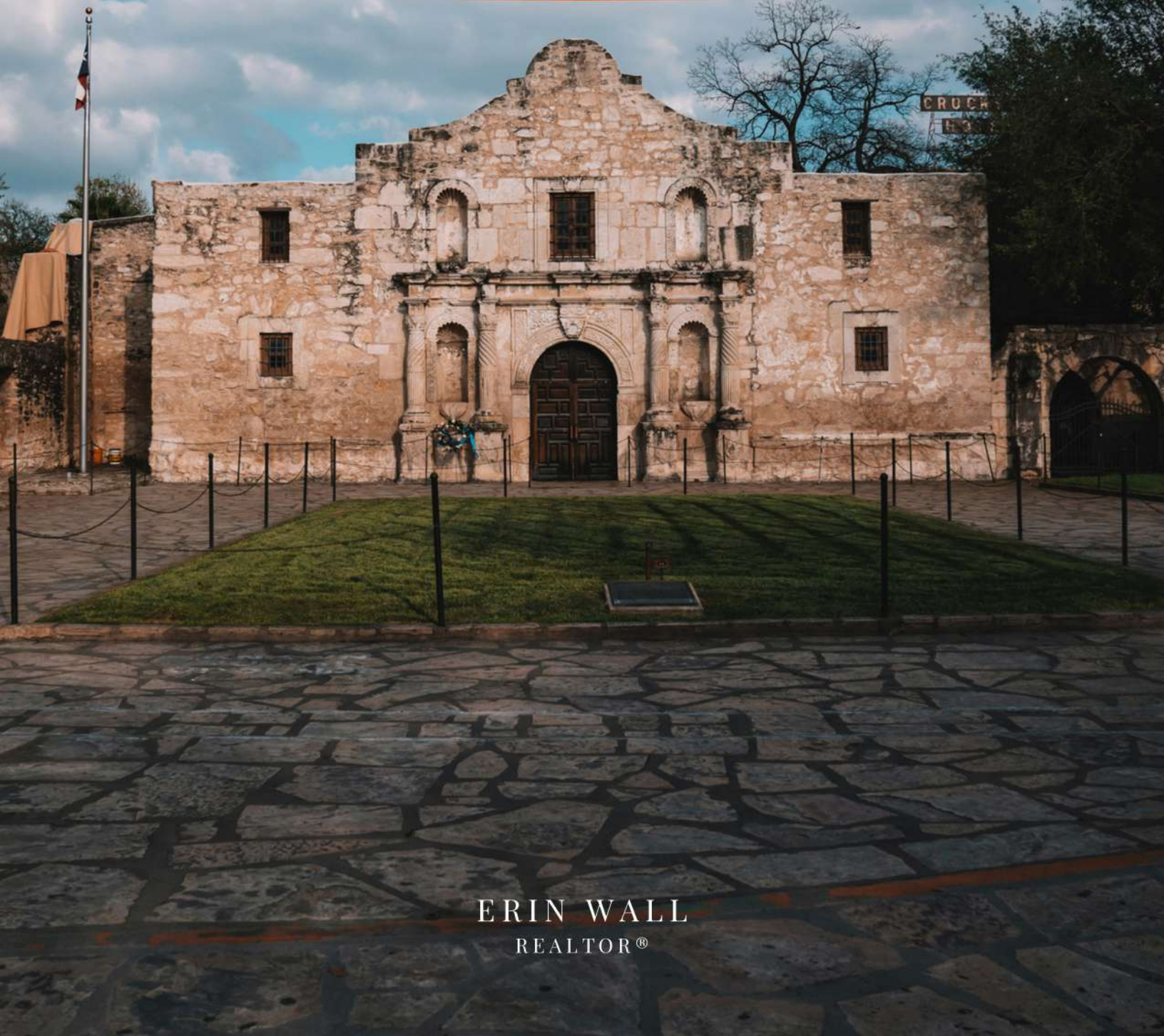

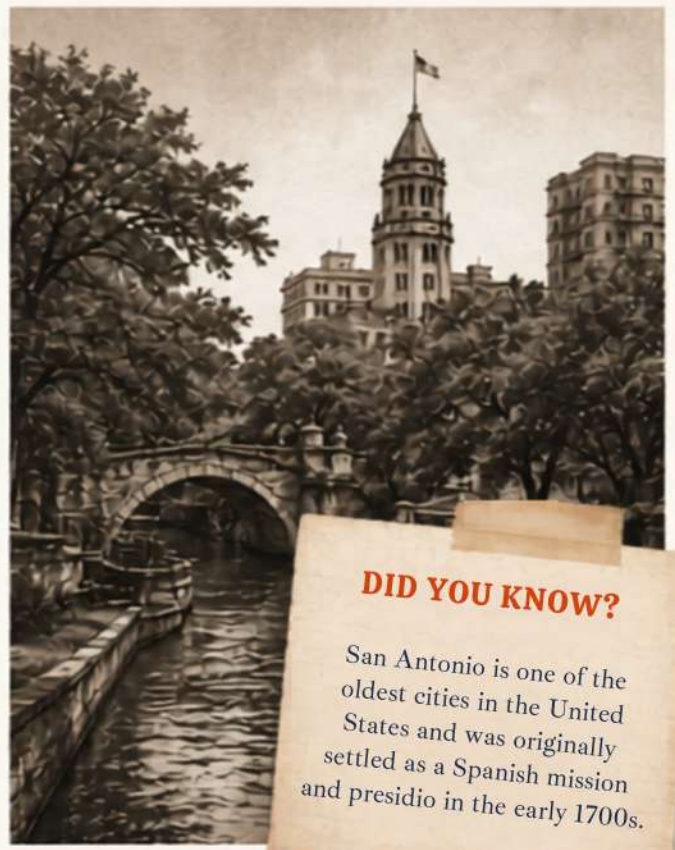

San Antonio's story is one of resilience, tradition, and transformation. From early Indigenous roots to a thriving modern city, our history shaped the vibrant community we call home today.



DID YOU KNOW?

San Antonio is one of the oldest cities in the United States and was originally settled as a Spanish mission and presidio in the early 1700s.

SPANISH ROOTS

In 1718, Spanish explorers established Mission San Antonio de Valero, later known as the Alamo, which was a presidio. This was the oldest part of the first permanent Spanish civilian settlement in Texas.

The missions were established not only to spread Christianity but also to blend European, Indian, and Mexican cultures in a way that would shape the city's identity for centuries.



A MEETING OF CULTURES

When Mexico gained independence in 1821, San Antonio became part of Mexico's families from the Southwestern region. In the 1960s, the United States all settled here, bringing with them there, bringing with them.

This rich blend is why San Antonio has a cultural depth you can feel everywhere in our food, our language, our celebrations, and our strong sense of community.

THE ALAMO & A CITY'S COURAGE

In 1836, during the Texas fight for independence, the Alamo became the site of a 13 day siege. Thus the battle was small, its impact was great.

"Remember the Alamo" became a rallying cry for Texas and a symbol of bravery that is still honored today.



GROWTH & RESILIENCE

Through the 1800s and 1900s, San Antonio grew steadily from a small frontier town to a major military base.

Our earliest hub was the West Texas Hub, Our earliest location, strong work ethic, and deep cultural roots helped us thrive through every era.

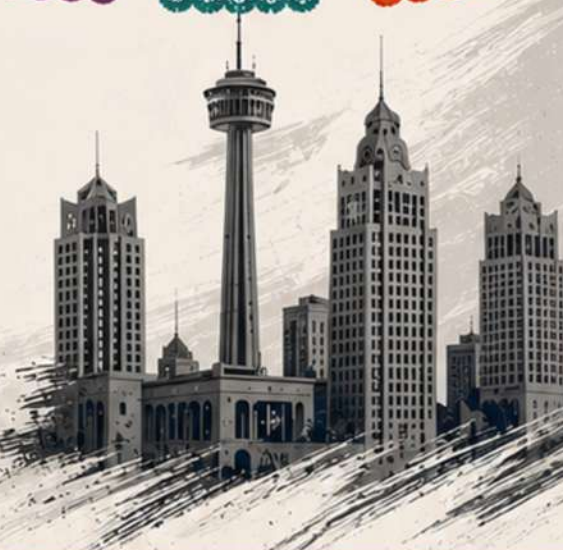

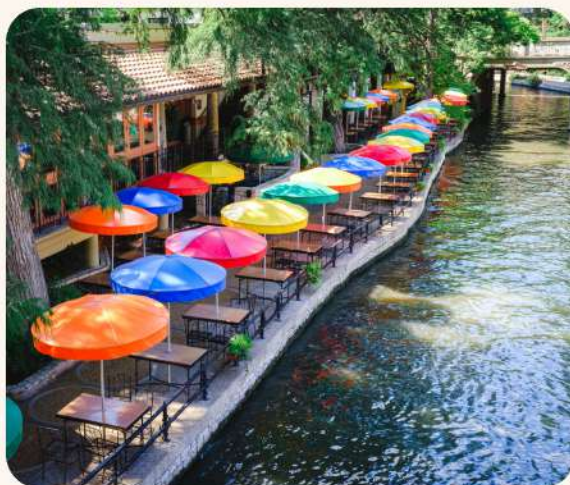

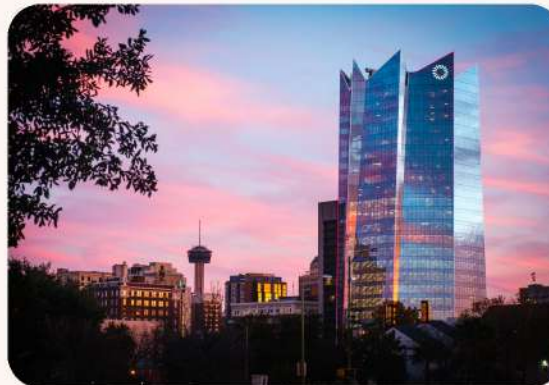
