1. Choosing a Property Before Understanding the Area

	Why it happens: Focus on price, size, or photos first. Risk: Commute challenges, inconvenient access, daily lifestyle mismatch. How to avoid it: Shortlist multiple areas first Test commutes at peak times Review roadway and service access
2.	Relying Solely on Online Research Why it happens: Online info feels complete but may be outdated. Risk: Pricing surprises, availability issues, missed requirements. How to avoid it: Verify details with official sources Confirm HOA rules directly Understand local transaction timelines
3.	Underestimating Administrative Timelines Why it happens: DMV, insurance, and utilities are assumed to be quick. Risk: Licensing delays, insurance gaps, service interruptions. How to avoid it: Start DMV and insurance updates immediately Schedule appointments early Keep required documents ready

4. Overlooking HOA Governance and Restrictions

Why it happens: HOA documents are reviewed too late. Risk: Approval delays, unexpected fees, usage limitations. How to avoid it: Request HOA documents early Review leasing, parking, and use rules Confirm approval timelines and fees
