QUICK FACTS

- **Outdoor Lifestyle:** Tucson is known for its outdoor lifestyle, with plenty of opportunities for hiking, biking, and other outdoor activities. The city is surrounded by five mountain ranges, offering stunning views and outdoor adventures for nature enthusiasts.
