

BROWN COUNTY, IN

Travel time from Louisville: 1 hour 24 minutes (driving) **Known for:** Vibrant fall foliage, an arts and crafts community in Nashville, Indiana, and extensive hiking and mountain biking trails.

Check out: Brown County State Park for scenic overlooks like Hesitation Point, shopping for unique crafts in downtown Nashville, and the Hard Truth Distillery for tours, ATV adventures, and an outdoor amphitheater.

FALL CREEK FALLS STATE PARK, TN

Travel time from Louisville: 4 hours 28 minutes (driving) **Known for:** Being one of the largest and most visited state parks in Tennessee, featuring Fall Creek Falls, which is one of the highest waterfalls east of the Rocky Mountains. **Check out:** The 256-foot Fall Creek Falls, numerous other

waterfalls like Cane Creek Falls and Piney Falls, and over 30 miles of hiking trails for exploring the gorges and cascades.

CUMBERLAND FALLS, KY

Travel time from Louisville: 2 hours 20 minutes (driving) Known for: Being the "Houseboat Capital of the World," a premier fishing destination (especially for striped bass), and a massive lake with over 1,200 miles of shoreline.

Check out: The Rattlesnake Run for a scenic fall foliage drive, Haney's Appledale Farm for apple picking, and the Lure Lodge at Lake Cumberland State Resort Park for hiking trails and lake views.
