A PERSONAL NOTE FROM KRIS

If part of you already knows it might be time, and part of you isn't ready at all, both of those feelings are allowed to be true.

I have sat at a lot of kitchen tables in Lakeshore, Windsor, Tecumseh and across Essex County having this exact conversation, and I have never once seen it be simple.

My name is Kris Ramotar. I have spent the last 8 plus years walking Windsor Essex families through some of the biggest decisions of their lives, and I have called this region home for 23 years myself, so this is not a market I studied from a distance. It is the community where my own family lives, eats, coaches, and volunteers.

This guide is not a sales pitch. I put it together because I kept meeting families who were quietly overwhelmed, not because they could not handle the paperwork or the packing, but because nobody had told them the truth about how much this decision touches. It touches your body, your schedule, your finances, and most of all, it touches your heart.

So before we talk about boxes or listing dates, I want to walk through what this season actually feels like, because I believe families make better decisions when they feel understood first and informed second.

You are allowed to grieve a house and still be excited about what comes next. Those two things live together more often than people expect.

The physical side nobody quite prepares you for

Most families picture downsizing as a moving day. In reality, the physical weight of it shows up months before a single box gets taped shut. It is the stairs that used to feel like nothing and now feel like a lot. It is the basement, the garage, and the spare room that quietly filled up over twenty or thirty years, because that is what homes do when a family lives in them fully.

Then there is the sheer number of decisions. Every drawer, every closet, every shelf holds something that has to be looked at and sorted, and after the fiftieth decision in a single afternoon, even simple choices start to feel exhausting. That exhaustion is real, and it is one of the biggest reasons families stall out halfway through.

KEEP

The pieces that belong in your next chapter, chosen on purpose, not out of habit.

CHERISH

Photos, letters, and small keepsakes set aside in a memory box of their own.

GIFT OR SELL

Furniture and items with life left in them, passed to family or a new home.

LET GO

The rest, released with a plan instead of guilt, one room at a time.

The families who get through this well almost never do it all at once, and they almost never do it alone. A little help, and a little patience with yourself, changes the entire experience.

The part that actually gets to people

A house is not just a structure. It is the chair where you read bedtime stories, the kitchen where every holiday started, and the driveway where a teenager once learned to drive.

So when I sit with a family who is considering a move like this, the physical to do list is rarely what weighs on them most. It is the quiet grief of walking away from a place that holds their whole story. It is the uncertainty of starting over somewhere smaller and unfamiliar. Sometimes it is guilt, especially for a parent who feels like leaving the home means letting go of a version of the family that used to gather there.

It is also common for a family to see this decision differently from each other. One adult child wants Mom and Dad settled somewhere easier. Another wants to hold onto the home a little longer. Those conversations can get tender fast, and they deserve to be handled with patience, not pressure.

None of this makes you dramatic or indecisive. It makes you human. A home this full of memory is worth grieving, even when moving on is genuinely the right call for your health, your finances, or your peace of mind.

The goal was never to erase the memories. It was to carry them forward into a home that finally fits the life you are living now.

- ☐ Walk through the home room by room and simply notice what matters most to you.

- ☐ Set aside a memory box for photos and keepsakes instead of trying to keep everything.
- ☐ Talk openly with family early, before decisions have to be made under pressure.
- ☐ Reach out for a plan, even if you are not ready to list, so you are never doing this alone.
