Conner's A-Maize-Ing Acres — Hilliard
Best for: Corn mazes, pumpkins, farm animals and Saturday fall fun. Opens October 3.

Congaree and Penn — North Jacksonville
Best for: Pumpkin picking, farm walks, live music and food trucks. Patch runs September 24–November 1.

Amazing Grace Family Farms — Green Cove Springs
Best for: Pumpkin picking, apple picking, crop maze, sunflower photos and kid-friendly attractions.

Diamond D Ranch — West Jacksonville
Best for: A tractor-pulled wagon ride, farm animals, pony rides and hands-on farm fun during its October 10 Family Fun Farm Day.

Amelia Island Coffee — Downtown Fernandina
Order: Hot Café Caramel.

Foxtail Coffee - Wildlight
Order: Carmel Apple Latte

Mocama Coffee — Fernandina Beach
Order: Toasted marshmallow cortado.

Kismet Coffee — Fernandina Beach
Order: Spice-forward chai latte with toasted pecan.

Holy Grounds Coffee House — Amelia Island
Order: Raised to Life—white mocha, brown sugar, oat milk and cinnamon.

Food Worth Leaving the House For

Wicked Bao — Downtown Fernandina
For: Pork belly ramen or the Bao Trio on a cool evening.

Burlingame — Fernandina Beach
For: Fried Brussels sprouts with mushrooms, cranberries and honey-roasted pecans.

Nana Teresa's Bake Shop — Downtown Fernandina
For: Cannoli, éclairs and a box of bakery treats to take home.

Southern Blend — Yulee
For: A sausage-gravy biscuit or breakfast sandwich on a fresh glazed donut.



Best Places for Fall Scenery

Fort Clinch State Park

Best for: The oak-canopied drive, maritime forest trails and late-afternoon bike rides.



Egans Creek Greenway

Best for: Quiet walking trails, marsh views, birds and wildlife.



Big Talbot Island State Park

Best for: Golden-hour photography, Boneyard Beach and the scenic A1A drive.

Nassau Crossing Park — Yulee

Best for: An easy family walk along 2.5 miles of trails surrounded by trees and greenery.

Florida's version of fall is more golden marsh, oak canopy and soft coastal light than changing leaves.

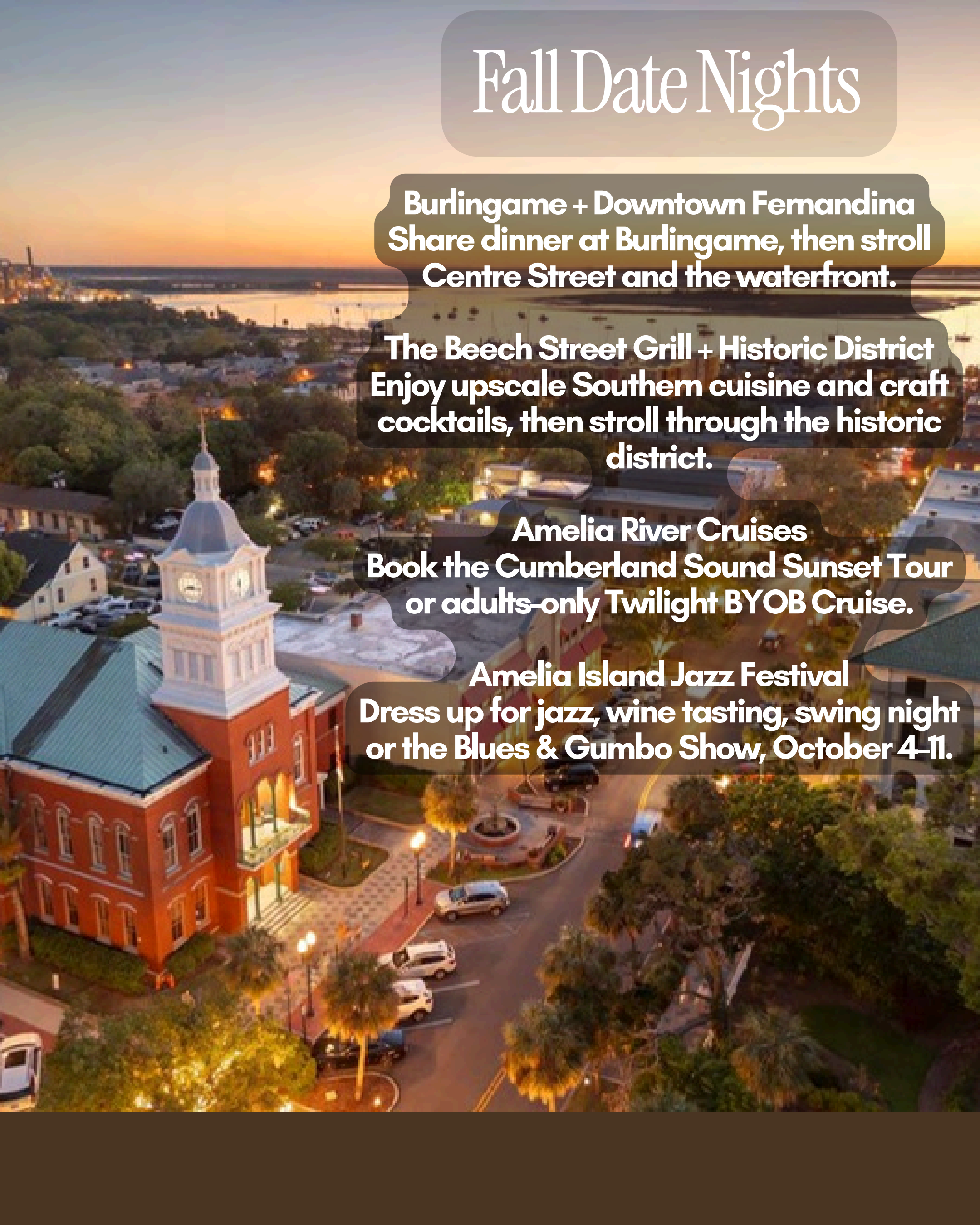
Fall Date Nights
