Register to vote, establish local healthcare providers, and transfer prescriptions. Research local dentists, veterinarians, and other essential service providers in advance.

DMV Requirements

Obtain your new Arizona driver's license and register vehicles within **10 days** of establishing residency. Bring proof of residency and previous registration documents.

Professional Moving

Schedule reputable movers at least **4 weeks in advance**, especially during peak season (October-April). Consider climate-controlled storage for sensitive items during summer moves.





Property Tax Rate


